Chancellor Park Primary School's Sports Funding 2016-2017 Evaluated

The government is providing additional funding of £150 million per year to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools. This funding - provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport - is allocated to primary schools up to 2020.

This funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

Chancellor Park Primary School has bought into the Chelmsford Schools Sports' Partnership (CSSP) which provides competitions in a variety of sports and also training to support teaching staff.

We have put in place an action plan to ensure this funding will improve our PE provision across the school. We plan to use this funding as stated below:

Hire specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with teachers and children during PE sessions.	£6,500 £165 per day to work alongside teachers developing teaching and learning.	The specialist teacher has worked alongside our teachers to support them in teaching P.E. This has improved the quality of PE lessons being taught.
Provide a broad range of sports clubs.	£608	We have been able to offer many clubs and have attended events and competitions for these.
Attending more sporting competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games.	Transport £500, Kit £60	This enables us to travel to and from competitions. We have been taking part in a growing amount of competitions outside of school.
Helping children to be active and make healthier life choices	Body care £200	This has encouraged children to take part in physical activities outside of school and also to raise awareness and understanding of how we can live a healthy and active lifestyle.
Ensuring the school has the correct sports equipment to teach a broad and varied curriculum.	£100	Updating and replacing sports equipment has helped us to provide more engaging PE lessons.
To join the Chelmsford Sport Partnership, which offers CPD for teachers and other members of staff and also runs a broad range of competitions for our children to attend.	£914	Attending CPD events has helped us to upskill our teachers and staff in teaching various sports and activities. We have also had the opportunity to make links with other schools to arrange additional sporting fixtures.

From September 2013, we will be held to account over how we spend our additional, ring-fenced funding. Ofsted will strengthen the coverage of PE and sport so that both schools and inspectors know how sport and PE is assessed in future as part of the school's overall provision.
