



# Class 1 Learning Overview 2020



## Spring Term



English	Maths	Theme	Other Subjects	What you can do to help your child this term
<p>This term we will learn the story of 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will retell the story and then change the characters and key parts to write our own versions.</p> <p>We will also focus on many cross-curricular pieces of writing, giving the children a purpose to write. This will include, creating a plant diary and using non-fiction books to research another country.</p> <p>Grammar and punctuation: Children will be continuing to use capital letters and full stops in their writing, as well as commas, exclamation marks and question marks.</p> <p>Children will also be learning to spell days of the week, adding s and es as the plural marker for nouns and verbs and to add the prefix un.</p>	<p>This term in Maths we will be learning about Place Value. We will cover: comparing and ordering numbers to 50, representing numbers using tens and ones, giving one more and one less than a given number and counting in 2s and 5s.</p> <p>We will also be working on addition and subtraction. We will add/subtract by counting on/back, find and make number bonds, find related facts and compare number sentences and add by making 10.</p> <p>Additionally, we will be introducing length, height, weight and volume.</p>	<p>Within our theme 'Where We Live' we will be covering the following subjects:</p> <p>Geography- We will name, locate and identify the four countries in the UK and learn the names of the surrounding seas. We will also be researching Mexico and create a fact file comparing Mexico City to Chelmsford. We will also be looking at maps and create our own map of the Three Little Pigs' Village.</p> <p>History-The children will be learning how Chelmsford has changed over the last 100 years.</p> <p>DT - We will build structures using a range of different materials. We will develop a food vocabulary and try various foods from around the world.</p> <p>Music - The children will learn to play percussion instruments together as a group.</p> <p>Art - We will be learning about a range of different artists.</p>	<p>Science - We will begin the term by learning about different materials. After half term we will cover plants. We will grow our own cress and record its growth in a diary. We will also learn about deciduous and evergreen trees.</p> <p>RE - We will continue learning about different religions and compare them to our own values and experiences.</p> <p>Computing - The children will be practising basic skills such as typing and mouse skills. We will create a presentation about Mexico.</p> <p>PE- Gymnastics and Dance</p> <p>PSHE- We will continue promoting the values of health and wellbeing through leading a healthy lifestyle. We will be discussing the differences and similarities between people and learn to respect them.</p>	<p>Please continue to read every night with your child and practice their spellings with them.</p> <p>This half term will have an emphasis on number. At home please practise help your child to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Recall number bonds to 20.</li> <li>- Recall one more and one less than to 50.</li> <li>- Write digits to 50.</li> <li>- Counting in 2s and 5s.</li> </ul>
