<p>We will be reading and writing a range of text types including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Creating stories based on the stories 'Escape from Pompeii and 'The Stone Age Boy'.</li> <li>❖ Writing non-fiction texts based on our learning.</li> </ul> <p>Grammar and punctuation: We will be focussing on carefully editing and assessing the effectiveness of our writing and suggesting improvements.</p> <p>We will also be focussing on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Using a wide range of sentence openers to make sentences more interesting.</li> <li>❖ Choosing nouns and pronouns appropriately to avoid repetition.</li> </ul>	<p>We will be covering a number of different areas of Maths including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Solving problems, including missing number problems, using addition subtraction, multiplication and division.</li> <li>❖ Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables.</li> <li>❖ Add and subtract amounts of money to give change in £ and p in practical contexts.</li> <li>❖ Interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.</li> <li>❖ Calculating the perimeter of a shape.</li> <li>❖ Recognise and use fractions of numbers and objects.</li> </ul>	<p>This term our themes in class are: Stone Age to Iron Age. Within this theme we will be covering the following subjects:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ History - We will be exploring the time period and how artefacts have been discovered.</li> <li>❖ Art- Creating cave paintings and our own bronze Age beakers.</li> <li>❖ Geography - We will be learning about volcanoes and linking it to our science topic of Rocks and soils.</li> <li>❖ D&amp;T - We will be making our own Stone Age food and Bronze Age beakers.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>❖ Science - Our topics will be 'Animals, including humans' and 'Rocks and Soils'.</li> <li>❖ ICT Skills - We will be working on word processing and internet safety this term.</li> <li>❖ PE- In P.E we will be continuing to develop outdoor games skills with Mr North. We are also lucky enough to have an expert from the cricket club to help teach the children cricket. Elm class will also be swimming this term (Oak will go in the summer term).</li> <li>❖ RE - In R.E. we will be learning about Moses and the Festival of Pesach.</li> <li>❖ MFL - In French we will be learning the different colours, clothes and food.</li> <li>❖ Music- We will be appreciating and responding to a range of music.</li> </ul>	<p>It has been wonderful to see the class mature and develop their independence during the last term. Thank you for your continued support with encouraging this.</p> <p>As always it is important that your child reads every night and that they are regularly questioned on what they have read to help them improve their comprehension.</p> <p>They should practice and learn their times tables and using these to derive answers to division questions.</p>
