Recognise place value of each digit in a two digit number (tens, ones) Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use <, > and = signs. Use place value and number facts to solve problems. Count in steps of 2, 3 and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward. Number - Addition and Subtraction Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100. Add and subtract numbers. Show that the addition of two numbers can be done in any order and subtraction cannot. Solve problems with addition and subtraction. Recognise and use the inverse relationship between addition and subtraction. Measurement: Money Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p); combine amounts to make a particular value. Find different combinations of coins. Solve simple problems in a practical context. Number - Multiplication and Division Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables, including recognising odd and even numbers.
