Explain unfamiliar words.</p> <p>Maths</p> <p>Revise multiplication tables: in order, random recall, rapid recall and creating word problems using multiplication, e.g. a tray has 6 eggs and there are 6 trays. How many eggs are there altogether?</p> <p>Homework/spellings</p> <p>Please practise spellings and read through homework together before handing in.</p>
